Under the auspices of the International Committee of Military Medicine (ICMM), the ICMM Center of Reference for Education on International Humanitarian Law and Ethics, and the NATO Centre of Excellence for Military Medicine (MILMED COE) together with the Chairman of the Health Care Working Group will co-jointly organize a Military Medical Ethics Workshop in Munich, Germany. The workshop will be held on 14-16 September 2015 at the Bundeswehr Medical Academy in Munich.

The objective of the workshop is the elaboration of an ethical analysis of the role of military medical services in the complex environment of an asymmetric conflict and the rules of the Geneva Convention. The intended audience for this workshop will be (OF 4/5) from NATO and partner members, legal advisors, medical advisors, commanders, medical planners for multinational missions under the NATO, EU or UN mandate but also, academia representatives from different countries around the world. The workshop is open for all member states of ICMM. The number of attendees, who can join military accommodation at the Bundeswehr Medical Academy in Munich, is limited to 30 people.

By car:

Leave the motorway at junction 99 Munich-Neuherberg and turn towards Munich on the B 13 / Ingolstadt road. After entering the city at the first intersection, turn right into Neuherbergstraße. After about 300 meters turn left into the barracks entrance.



By bus and train / public transport

From Munich central station take the subway line 2 to the stop Harthof. From there by bus 141 or 170 bus (runs not on Sundays) and descend at Rose-Pichler-Weg. The stop is right at the barracks. The journey takes around 25 minutes.

By flight:

From Franz Josef Strauss Airport by S-Bahn line 1 to stop Munich-Feldmoching. From there take the bus 170 (does not operate on Sundays) and descend at Rose-Pichler-Weg. The stop is right at the main entrance of the barracks. The journey takes around 47 minutes.
